Benefits of a Neighborhood Watch Program

- **Create** a greater sense of security, well-being, and reduce fear of crime.
- **Reduce** the risk of being a crime victim.
- **Train** on how to observe and report suspicious activities occurring in your neighborhood.
- **Build** a stronger sense of community with your neighbors.



How Does it Work?

1. Neighbors *join together* to provide information about their households.
2. Participants receive *training* in order to recognize suspicious activity.
3. Participants *immediately report* what they know to law enforcement
4. Law enforcement *responds* and takes appropriate action. If the suspect is not caught, your recognition and notes could be vital in their apprehension and conviction.
